



ELECTRICAL SAFETY CHECKLIST FOR WA HOMES

Keep your family safe and your home compliant with WA electrical standards. Use this checklist to inspect each area of your home and tick items as you go.

GENERAL HOME SAFETY

- ☐ Test all smoke alarms — replace batteries if needed
- ☐ Check the main switchboard for any burn marks or corrosion
- ☐ Verify that circuit breakers are working and clearly labelled
- ☐ Ensure proper earthing and grounding throughout your home

KITCHEN SAFETY

- ☐ Inspect power points near sinks or water for damage
- ☐ Avoid overloading sockets with too many appliances
- ☐ Check cords for fraying or heat damage

LIVING AREAS & BEDROOMS

- ☐ Check extension cords and power boards for wear or loose plugs
- ☐ Avoid running cords under carpets or behind furniture
- ☐ Make sure lights and lamps are secure and not overheating
- ☐ Use surge-protected power boards for added safety

OUTDOOR & GARAGE AREAS

- ☐ Make sure outdoor and garden lighting is weatherproof
- ☐ Inspect outdoor outlets for cracks or moisture
- ☐ Keep tools and cords dry and neatly stored
- ☐ Only use extension cords rated for outdoor use

MAINTENANCE & HABITS

- ☐ Schedule a professional electrical inspection every 1-3 years
- ☐ Teach all family members basic electrical safety habits
- ☐ Keep a record of safety checks and any maintenance work

WHEN TO CALL A LICENSED ELECTRICIAN

- ☐ Sparks, smoke, or burning smells
- ☐ Frequent circuit breaker trips
- ☐ Flickering or dimming lights
- ☐ Buzzing or crackling sounds from outlets or appliances

STAY SAFE, PERTH

- ✓ Review this checklist every 6-12 months
